

Mrs. Chein Chana Miscalche was eagerly anticipating her oldest son Refoel Meir's bar mitzvah, set to take place in early Kislev. And then, in one horrific rocket attack on October 7, Simchas Torah morning, her father, husband Nesanel, and 12-year-old son Refoel Meir were tragically killed. Now, this bereaved daughter, wife and mother was left to mourn in place of celebrating.

Techayeinu, an organization dedicated to sending support and practical help to victims of the Gaza war, wanted to do something, to send a message of supreme encouragement to Mrs. Miscalche; and so, they spearhead a campaign to complete *Shas Mishnayos l'iluy nishmas* Refoel Meir ben Nesanel by 9 Kislev, the day that would have been Refoel Meir's bar mitzvah.

Many people stepped up to the plate and committed to learn *masechtos*, determined to give this gift to a precious *neshamah* so tragically taken, as well as a message of care and concern to Refoel Meir's mother.

Yet, as the bar mitzvah date drew closer, there still remained some outstanding material to be learned – namely, Seder Taharos, which includes some of the most difficult sections of *mishnayos*. Chevrah Lomdei Mishnah was asked if their esteemed *talmidei chachamim* could complete the learning and if, due to the nature of the circumstances and the limited funding available, this could be done pro bono. We agreed to take this on, although ultimately, an inspired client heard about the project and insisted upon sponsoring the learning himself.


Our dedicated Torah scholars were particularly touched by this project; and indeed, with the help of Hashem, the goal of marking the bar mitzvah day with a *siyum* was realized. In fact, Techayeinu arranged for the *siyum* on Shishah Sidrei Mishnah to be broadcast live to Meron, where the immediate family made a *siyum* masechta simultaneously.




Better than a Segulah (a division of Chevrah Lomdei Mishnah) offers the opportunity to sponsor
